

## ROMAN BLIND - MEASURING FOR A BLIND FITTED OUTSIDE THE WINDOW RECESS



For a blind fitted outside the window recess, the width of the blind is the width of the window recess plus 5-10 cm added on each side.

The recommended length of the blind is the length from the window sill or the floor to the top edge of the window recess plus around 30-35 cm (this is optional, but minimum 15 cm). An open blind is around 30-35 cm long, so fitting it around 30-35 cm above the window will allow for easy opening of the window when the blind is fully open.
